Hosted by the Organization of Student Representatives (OSR), and featuring ERAS specialists, the [webinar](#) will provide a best practices overview of the MyERAS application and answer applicant questions.

What 2019 Applicants Can Do Now:

Right now, within MyERAS, students are able to:

- Create personal statement(s)
- Send Letter Request Forms to the people who will write your Letters of Recommendation (LoRs)
- Authorize the release of the COMLEX-USA and/or USMLE transcripts
- Manage documents

Some documents are assigned to selected programs by default and others require students to make assignments to programs manually. The **Assignments Checklist** within MyERAS can help your students understand which documents are automatically assigned to programs and which require applicants' manual assignment.

Researching Programs:

To help applicants determine which programs are the best fit for their interests and skills, programs may provide additional details about their selection criteria and application requirements in ERAS. When students search for programs in MyERAS, informational icons will appear beside the names of programs that have provided additional information, which applicants can view by clicking on the program link.

Applicants are responsible for uploading their photo. New portraits may be done free of charge by making an appointment with the [Creative Services Team](#).
