Dear Applicant,

On September 5, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. ET, you may begin applying to ACGME-accredited residency programs, ten days before programs are given access to applications and supporting documents on September 15. All applications submitted September 5-15 will be date-stamped "September 15, 2018" for programs.

Preparing for September Early Opening

We encourage you to review the tasks below to ensure that you are prepared and ready when early application opening begins:

Carefully Check Your Application

Please take the time to review and carefully proofread your application before certifying and submitting. Once you certify and submit your application—including those completed September 5 through September 15—you will not be able to make any changes except to the Personal Information section of your MyERAS application. Application fee refunds will not be provided for any reason, so please certify and submit only when you are certain your application is complete and correct.

Research Programs Before Applying

Please practice due diligence and research individual programs' requirements and deadlines during your application process. When you search for programs in MyERAS, **informational icons will appear beside the names of programs that have provided additional information**, which you can view by clicking on or selecting the program's link.

Letters of Recommendation (LoRs)

All letters of recommendation (LoRs) must be uploaded using the ERAS LoR

Portal (LoRP) by LoR authors or their designees. The designees may not be members of the teaching hospital (in an advising role) or medical school staff supporting in the application process. LoRs that have been uploaded can be assigned to programs under the Documents tab and LoR section under the Programs Applied/Saved tab.
