Dear GSA Colleagues,

I am writing to announce that a new Psychiatry Residency Program, based at Osceola Regional Medical Center (within the greater Orlando region) and the Orlando VAMC has just received initial accreditation from the ACGME for 24 categorical positions and is seeking immediate applicants. This program is part of the University of Central Florida (UCF)-Hospital Corporation of America North Florida Division Consortium and will accept 6 categorical residents per year. The program will be directed by Dr. Martin Klapheke. Osceola Regional Medical Center is a 400-bed level II trauma hospital and is the sole provider of a growing list of specialty and subspecialty services within Osceola County. The Orlando VAMC, a new state of the art facility with multispecialty services across from UCF in the Lake Nona region of Orlando, will be a major participating site for residents. The VAMC shares a campus with the national SimLEARN simulation facility. Child and adolescent psychiatry rotations will occur at Nemours Children's Hospital-Orlando. The psychiatry residency program is the 20th accredited UCF/HCA consortium program and residents will work alongside residents and fellows in multiple other ACGME programs including internal medicine, emergency medicine, obstetrics & gynecology, neurology, and transitional medicine.

The program will be participating in the NRMP Supplemental Offer and Acceptance Program (SOAP). Applications following SOAP should be submitted through Krystal D. Hernandez, GME Program Coordinator, Psychiatry Residency Program, Osceola Regional Medical Center, at krystal.hernandez@hcahealthcare.com (an updated CV, three letters of recommendation from Psychiatry Faculty (one from the Department Chair), transcripts from medical school, USMLE Transcripts, MSPE/Deans Letter, and an updated Personal Statement). Qualified applicants will be selected for interviews.
