

# LCOM SOFTWARE SYSTEMS AT A GLANCE

## For Entering Medical Students

Upon acceptance into the College of Medicine, students juggle a handful of credentials:

- **Your “Nine-Five Number” (#95):** official university ID#
- **University level credentials:** exist in the CAMPUS domain; colloquially called your “NetID”
- **College of Medicine credentials:** exist in the MED domain; colloquially called your “COMID”
- **UVM Medical Center credentials:** exists in the FAHC domain (hospital); colloquially called your “M-number”; not a concern until September of your first year, which is when you are provided with the training and informational materials related to these credentials
