My name is Erik Siedow with the American Urological Association (AUA) Office of Research. We're in the process of reaching out to medical school leadership to share information about our new Physician Scientist Residency Training Award (PSRTA), which will be open to <u>fourth year medical students and</u> recent medical school graduates this June.

The PSRTA supports three years of intensive research training embedded within urology residency and is intended to develop urologic surgeon-scientists who can effectively engage with basic scientists, successfully compete for independent research funding and ultimately lead robust research programs. **The PSRTA resident will complete an eight-year training program in urology beginning July 2019**. The trainee will complete the first two years of clinical training and then matriculate into the three-year research training program. The final three years of clinical training will conclude the PSRTA training program.

The following institutions have been selected as eligible Program Sites: University of California, Los Angeles; University of Michigan; University of Washington; and Wake Forest University. The successful candidate will begin residency in July 2019.
