

## Stamford Hospital Internal Medicine Residency Program

Stamford Hospital is a regional referral center in Fairfield County, CT, a suburb of NYC, and a major educational affiliate of Columbia. Third-year students from Columbia rotate through clerkships here in Medicine, as well as OB/GYN, Surgery and Primary Care, and many of our physicians hold faculty appointments at Columbia. Our residency program in Internal Medicine includes approximately 20 house staff, with 7 interns recruited yearly.

We are a Planetree Hospital with an emphasis on humanistic care, and recently opened a spacious new state-of-the-art hospital building. Our attending physicians offer expertise across the breadth of internal medicine, providing specialized care, advanced procedures and subspecialty teaching. Invasive, catheter-based cardiac therapies, advanced endoscopic procedures, an acute stroke team, oncologists affiliated with the Dana Farber Cancer Center, a pulmonary/critical care team recognized for innovative approaches to intensive care and an evidence-based pain management program are some of the areas of expertise here.

Medical students planning a career in Internal Medicine who are looking for rigorous clinical training, a patient-centered and inter-professional approach to clinical care and opportunities for individualized training may find a good match here.
