

Firestone Medical Research Building (FMRB) Construction Notice #6
May-June 2021

The steel erection supporting the FMRB's skeleton concluded with an impromptu topping off ceremony held earlier this month. It was delightful to have so many members of our community place their names on the final beam. Construction activities now pivot to formalizing the bond that joins the HSRF and FMRB and pouring the concrete slabs on levels 1-4 of the FMRB. Below are the key activities impacting our community.

- Sectional cutting of the HSRF concrete decking and roof to support the FMRB penthouse and mechanicals. This work will impact the 4th floor of HSRF with an increase of noise and vibration anticipated to be most disruptive from May 26th through May 31st.
- Continued concrete cutting and steel deck anchoring in the HSRF basement. We project the peak of disruptive activities will occur during the first week of June. During this time HSRF occupants can expect to increased use of the south HSRF elevator. As the schedule is finalized, we will notify occupants of the anticipated disruption and duration.
- The contractor supporting the City of Burlington's water tower restoration has returned. Over the past week, the equipment supporting this work has been reinstalled. The sound and vibrational disruptions accompanying this project are mainly caused by the large air compressor.
